

Empowered by the Blood #4: Dominion in my Walk

Introduction:

Recap of Last Weeks

- 1). Jesus spilled his blood at the **whipping post**, the place of humiliation. A place where the world would break us down, Therefore his blood brought life to our whipping post.
 - 2). Jesus Spilled his blood on the **CROWN OF THORNS** covering the curse of poverty.
 - 3). Mary preached on the Blood covering the **work of our hands**, our creativity and ingenuity.
- Note-** The only man made things in heaven will be the scars are the hands of Christ. And how our hands represented the Gifts, our authority and Dominion.

I want to continue on that thought in dealing with our dominion, so that not only do we understand our place as human beings made In the Image of God, but that our position is covered by the blood of Jesus.

Gen 1:26

And **God said**, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them **have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Dominion - radah (raw-daw'); a primitive root; **to tread down**, i.e. subjugate; specifically, to crumble off: KJV - (come to, make to) have dominion, prevail against, reign, (bear, make to) rule,- r, over), take.

The purpose of Mankind is to establish the authority of God upon the earth, but we know that the enemy has spoiled that plan through deception in the Garden. But the greatest deception is not what happened in the garden in comparison to **the lie that he convinces** Christians that He remains in dominion.

AFTER THE CROSS – We have been promoted and the devil has been demoted!

When Jesus was crucified, His blood poured froth not only from His HANDS, BUT HIS FEET as well... this was no accident, this was even foretold hundreds of years before in a prophetic song of David.

David in psalms...

Ps 22:16-18

For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They **pierced** My hands and My feet;

17 I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me.

18 They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots.

His blood spilling on His Feet establishes our walk, He has brought life to our walk, Im not talking about your strut, but your Spiritual walk. Your foregoing, The carrying of your life. Your Journey in HIM.

POINT ONE: HIS BLOOD BRINGS AUTHORITY AND DOMINION

Example of establishing Abraham

Gen 13:14-17

14 And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward:

15 For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.

16 And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered.

17 **Arise, walk** through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.

Example of Establishing the children of Israel after EGYPT

Josh 1:3

Every place that the sole of your **foot will tread** upon I have given you, as I said to Moses.

Both of these are examples of How God promised to establish his people, but there is one common denominator.. **You have to WALK**. You must plant your feet with the faith that God has given you the land.

Remember the word DOMINION – Means to TREAD UPON. This promise is alive for us today.

Rom 16:20

And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

Ref: Matt 5:9

9 Blessed are **the peacemakers**: for they **shall be called** the children of God.

Peace makers? We bring by our presence...Where we go, where we walk we are able to bring the PEACE of God into the midst. Because of His Blood we are the children of God and the mark of the children of God is that we establish the presence of God.

As we walk in our BLOOD given DOMINION Christ will use our walk to crush the enemy of our souls

[Shall bruise Satan] Shall give you the dominion over the great adversary of your souls, and over all his agents who, through his influence, endeavor to destroy your peace and subvert your minds.

[Will bruise] The "language" here refers to the prediction in Gen 3:15. It here means to "subdue, to gain the victory over." It denotes Paul's confidence that they "**would" gain the victory**, and would be able to overcome all the arts of those who were endeavoring to sow discord and contention among them.

We have the dominion of God, where we walk we settle it, we are peace makers and because of our union with Christ and his blood we bring peace and order to the chaos, we set the tone. So the God of Peace through us brings peace under our FEET.

Authority and Gangs...

POINT TWO: The INVISIBLE DOMINION

Col 1:15-16

15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

The Sands of Galaiee... thundering stomping in the Heavenly realm.

Wherever Jesus Walked, it disturbed the wicked spiritual realm. They came out running EXPOSED by his dominion. It's hard to keep quiet when someone steppin on you. MY HAND, MY FOOT MY HEAD!

Mal 4:3

3 You shall trample the wicked, For they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet On the day that I do this, "Says the LORD of hosts.

And because of HIS BLOOD we overcome, the enemy hears when we are coming, he acknowledges the thundering of our authority.

Luke 10:17-20

17 Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name."

18 And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.

19 Behold, I give you the **authority to trample** on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

20 Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

Trample - NT:3817

paio (pah'-yo); a primary verb; to hit (as if by a single blow and less violently than NT:5180); specifically to sting (as a scorpion):

Our walk is designed to trample and disrupt the kingdom of Darkness.... Because we disrupt his chaos, we are the children of God, We BRING PEACE.

Rom 10:15

15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written:

"How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace,
Who bring glad tidings of good things!"

Term of Walk –

yalak (yaw-lak'); a primitive root [compare OT:1980]; to walk (literally or figuratively); causatively, to carry (in various senses):

KJV - X again, away, bear, bring, carry (away), come (away), depart, flow, + follow (-ing), get (away, hence, him), (cause to, made) go (away, -ing, -ne, one's way, out), grow, lead (forth), let down, **march, prosper**, + pursue, cause to run, **spread**, take away ([-journey]), vanish, (cause to) walk (-ing), wax, X be weak.

As we walk in the blood given dominion we spread and Prosper. Do you have your marching orders?

2 Cor 5:7

(For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

Eph 2:10

10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should **walk in them**.

John 12:3

Then Mary took a pound of very costly oil of spikenard, anointed the feet of Jesus, **and wiped His feet** with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the oil.

Commentary of Above

Why not the head, as usual? She wanted to give honor to that which brought peace, she spilt her life savings and future on that which treaded on her bondage.

HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET!

Luke 19:13

13 And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.

APPLICATION: Prayer Walking

Prayer walking is praying onsite with insight, there is a difference when you are praying for Africa and when you are in Africa praying for Africa.

He sent them into the place he was to go...

The Battle plan of Christ

Luke 10:1

10:1 After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place **where He Himself was about to go**

We go into the city with the transfer of authority

Luke 10:16

He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me."

Ps 24:7-9

7 Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors!
